ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

1. Provisions and stipulations of Southwest Ohio Air Pollution control are to be observed:
 - Burning shall take place only when atmospheric conditions will readily dissipate contaminants.
 - Fire shall not create a visibility hazard on roadways, railroad tracks, or air fields.
 - Fire shall be located at a point on the premises no less than 1,000 feet from any inhabited building other than those located on the same premises.
 - The material to be burned shall be stacked and dried to provide the best practicable condition for efficient burning.
 - No materials shall be burned that contain rubber, grease, asphalt, or liquid petroleum products or trash.
 - The fire shall be at least 1,000 feet from the boundary of the cities of Loveland and Milford, Ohio.
 - Burning shall not take place when an air quality alert, warning, or emergency is in effect.
2. The location for open burning shall not be less than 50 feet from any structure.
3. Fire shall be of minimum size for the intended purpose.
4. Open burning shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished.
5. A fire extinguisher(s) of 4A rating or other approved extinguishing equipment must be available for immediate use.
6. Miami Township Fire & EMS is to be notified on the day of the fire prior to burning. 248-3700.

Violations of any of the conditions of this PERMIT shall be grounds for revocation of this PERMIT and refusal to grant future permits, as well as imposition of other sanctions provided by law.

This PERMIT does not relieve you of the duty to comply with any other applicable laws or regulations.

Justified complaints of open burning that create an offensive or objectionable condition due to smoke or odor emissions are grounds for modification or revocation of this PERMIT.
