## RESOLUTION 2016-08

The Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio met at the Miami Township Civic Building on January 19, 2016 with the following members present: Karl Schultz, Ken Tracy and Mary Makley Wolff.

MS. WOLFF made a motion to adopt the following Resolution:

### **RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS ALONG STATE ROUTE 131 BETWEEN MCCORMICK TRAIL AND LAKEWOOD DRIVE, DISPENSING WITH A SECOND READING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Miami Township Board of Trustees in collaboration with the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District, hereinafter referred to as the CCTID and the Clermont County Engineer's Office, are undertaking improvements to a portion of State Route 131 Improvement Project (CCTID No. 90290), including improvements to SR 131 approximately halfway between McCormick Trail to the east and Lakefield Drive to the west, which will benefit the new Seipelt Elementary School (the "School"), all as further described, developed and set forth in plans and documents on file with the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (the "CCTID") and the Clermont County Engineer's Office (the "CCEO") (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), and

**WHEREAS**, Miami Township desires the CCTID to construct the said improvements to allow safe turning movements, access and the free flow of through traffic on the subject roadways and which will benefit the School and its operation, and

**WHEREAS**, the CCTID is the lead agency overseeing and managing, in coordination with the CCEO, Miami Township, and the Milford Exempted Village School District (the "School District"), the construction of the improvements and has added the Project to its Regional Transportation Improvement Program (the "RTIP"), and

**WHEREAS**, Miami Township will provide funds to the CCTID for this project to cover costs of these Project improvements in the amount of Five hundred thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$500,000.00) (the "Funding"), in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding with the School District, dated February 19, 2015 and per the First Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement with the CCTID for developing transportation improvement projects, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Miami Township ("Board"), Clermont County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Five hundred thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$500,000.00) is hereby appropriated for the improvement and the Township Administrator is directed to prepare a Purchase Order to encumber said amount and the Township Administrator is hereby authorized to take such actions and prepare and execute on behalf of the Trustees such additional related documents as required and convey the Funding to the CCTID to effect the purpose of this resolution.

SECTION 2. Miami Township hereby requests, ratifies and confirms that the CCTID proceed with construction of the aforesaid improvements.

SECTION 3. That the Township Administrator transmits to the CCTID a fully executed copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 4: That the Board does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to Section 504.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and well-being of the residents of the Township in order to ensure this project stays on schedule to allow for this safety improvement to be completed on schedule.


SECTION 6: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
