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#### **RESOLUTION 2025-13**

A motion was made to adopt the following Resolution:

# RESOLUTION LOWERING THE SPEED LIMIT ON CERTAIN STREETS IN MIAMI TOWNSHIP, WAIVING A SECOND READING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Miami Township Service Director has determined that the statutory vehicular speed limit established by Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.21 is greater than the considered reasonable and safe speed on certain streets in the Township and seeks to lower the permitted speed; and

WHEREAS, the Board has caused to be made an engineering and traffic investigation upon the roads to be changed; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the belief of the Board that such investigation confirms that the statutory speed limit of 55 miles per hour is not reasonable or safe.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees ("Board") of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio, by authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.21, as follows:

**SECTION 1**: That the statutory speed limit on the following streets shall be lowered to 25 miles per hour and that this speed limit should be properly posted:
